Revised Delegations Manual

This policy rescinds FRNSW Delegations Manual dated 22 May 2013

The FRNSW Delegations Manual has been revised and published on the Intranet.

Key points

The key changes are:

- Updated links to the new provisions of the Government Sector Employment Act 2013, and its associated Regulations and Rules.
- Revised delegations for conduct and discipline.
- Amended delegation to allow Area Commanders and Assistant Directors to approve air travel.

Hazards at aircraft accident sites

The Australian Transport Safety Bureau and the Department of Defence have published a 6th edition of their booklet *Hazards at aircraft accident sites: guidance for police and emergency personnel.*

A copy of this booklet was posted to all fire stations and Zone Offices in November.

Links to electronic versions of the booklet and the associated *Aviation Accident Checklist* can be found on the Aviation Incidents Toolkit on the Intranet.

Key points

Hazards at aircraft accident sites: guidance for police and emergency personnel assists emergency personnel to

- have an awareness of hazards at an aircraft accident site
- consider how to manage the hazards
- understand the reporting requirements for military and civil aircraft accidents
- understand the requirements of the *Transport Safety Investigation Act 2003* and the *Defence Aviation Safety Manual*
- manage and control the accident site to preserve essential evidence for investigations.

Who needs to read these documents?

All officers and firefighters should be aware of these guidelines and follow them when responding to aircraft accidents.

2015 SIMS release

SIMS calendars for 2015 have been developed and published to the <u>SIMS calendars toolkit</u> on the Intranet. Hardcopies have been distributed to Fire Stations.

A number of SIMS worksheets for both equipment and appliances have also been revised and published either to the <u>SIMS worksheets for equipment</u> or <u>SIMS worksheets for appliances</u> toolkits.

Procedure for SIMS calendars

On 1st January 2015, SIMS calendars for 2014 should be removed from the SIMS board and filed in the Station. SIMS calendars for 2015 should then be loaded into the SIMS board.

Procedure for SIMS worksheets

Paper copies of SIMS worksheets are distributed by mail, with SIMS calendars, or with equipment as it is installed. As soon as you receive new SIMS worksheets relevant to your appliance:

- Remove the old worksheets from the SIMS board.
- Replace them with the new worksheets.

Old SIMS worksheets should be disposed of.

If you are missing any of the required worksheets for your appliance, download them from the <u>SIMS</u> worksheets for equipment toolkit, print them out, and post them on your SIMS board.

Highlights of the revised SIMs worksheets include:

- <u>SIMS worksheet, Appliances</u> revised to include checking the cabin protections system (where it is fitted). This check is weekly (bushfire season), monthly (out of season), and before deployment (strike teams).
- <u>SIMS worksheet</u>, <u>GLM Mini-Rescue voltage detector</u>, revised to include a daily challenge test of the detector which should be rotated amongst staff so that all are familiar with the detector.
- SIMS worksheets for hydraulic rescue equipment revised to include checking the blade of hydraulic cutters for damage. The Road accident rescue (RAR) kit has been added to the SIMS worksheet for the Rapid intervention kit.
- All SIMS worksheets for specialised gas and radiation detectors have been revised.
- <u>SIMS worksheet, MSA Evolution thermal imaging camera</u>, revised to include the new retractable lanyard for safely connecting to the SCBA harness.
- <u>SIMS worksheet, Ground monitors Dual inlet</u>, revised to include the new Protek monitor.
- <u>SIMS worksheet, Ground monitors Single inlet</u>, published to cover the single inlet monitor being installed in some country stations.
- SIMS worksheet, Cordage: Height safety pack revised to update kit contents.
