#### **POLICIES**

### **Static Water Supply Program**

The revised policy on the Static Water Supply Program has been published on the Intranet.

This policy rescinds In Orders 1998/22, Static water supply program.

#### Key points

- 1. The Static Water Supply (SWS) Program identifies static water supplies in high risk bushfires areas. The program is community based and provides opportunities for improving communication between firefighters, Community Fire Unit members and residents.
- 2. The policy has been reviewed and updated to reflect:
  - the transfer of responsibility for the SWS Program from Community Safety to the Bushfire Section
  - the contribution of Community Fire Units
  - improved data collection, mapping capabilities and reporting.
- 3. To support Station Commanders running SWS programs in their areas, the <u>SWS</u> Toolkit on the Intranet includes:
  - a new SWS Checklist for Station Commanders, and
  - a video on the SWS program.
- 4. SWS information for Community Fire Unit members is published on the <u>CFU portal</u>.
- 5. Members of the public can access information about the SWS program on our <u>Internet</u> site.

#### Who needs to read this policy?

All firefighters, Station Commanders and Zone Management teams need to read this policy as they may be involved in implementing the SWS program or use static water supplies during bushfires.

#### **National Terrorism Public Alerts**

The revised procedure for <u>National Terrorism Public Alerts</u> has been published on the Intranet.

This procedure rescinds In Orders 2008/14, Security alerts.

#### Key points

- 1. The Attorney General's Department, in accordance with the National Counter-Terrorism Plan, assigns levels of National Terrorism Public Alert.
- 2. This procedure details the security measures FRNSW must take at each level of alert.
- 3. The policy has been reviewed and updated to reflect:
  - changes in organisation structure, position titles and operations
  - changes in NSW counter-terrorism arrangements.
