POLICIES

Firefighting foam

The <u>Firefighting foam policy</u> (Version 01) has been published on the Intranet. The <u>Firefighting Foam toolkit</u> on the intranet has also been updated.

Key points

- The policy describes FRNSW firefighting foam capability, and the policies relating to its use at incidents, procurement and disposal.
- The policy notes that all FRNSW firefighting foams are fluorine-free, non-persistent and readily biodegradable.
- The policy provides advice to FRNSW commanders and firefighters around the use of foam at an incident, and the environmental effects it may have.
- The policy provides advice on training with foam.
- The policy provides advice around the use of firefighting foam from other parties.

For detailed instructions on use of firefighting foam and equipment, refer to the *Recommended Practice – Firefighting foam and foam-making equipment*.

Review of Residential Priority Status

Permanent Firefighters

It is the responsibility of employees who are claiming residential priority status to notify the Manager Operational Staffing of any change in location of their primary residence.

Employees who notify the Manager Operational Staffing prior to Thursday 28 March 2019 of an earlier change of primary residence will have their records updated and no further action will be taken except to adjust the Transfer Register(s), if necessary, to reflect their correct residential address.

Any employee whose primary residence is found to be incorrect after 28 March 2019 will be removed from all Transfer Registers in accordance with Clause 28 of the Permanent Award.

Review of Kilometre Allowance payments

As a result of a decision of the Industrial Relations Commission of NSW, Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) is currently correcting kilometre allowance payments made to employees who held/hold residential priority status on a Transfer Register under Clause 28 of the Permanent Award and who were recalled to duty between 14 November 2014 and 30 November 2018.

FRNSW intends to make all outstanding recall kilometre allowance payments on Thursday 25 April 2019 using the Transfer Register and primary residence records held by the Manager Operational Staffing on Thursday 28 March 2019.

Employees who are later found to have received an incorrect recall kilometre allowance payment on 25 April 2019 because they failed to update their primary residence with the Manager Operational Staffing prior to Thursday 28 March 2019 may be subject to disciplinary action.
