Major Structure Collapse Sub Plan to the Major Incident Management Plan

FRNSW's <u>Major Incident Management Plan</u> (MIMP) ensures that FRNSW provides effective, coordinated response to major incidents in NSW in support of the <u>State Emergency</u> <u>Management Plan</u> (EMPLAN).

Sub plans to the MIMP detail requirements for dealing with specific types of incidents and should be read in conjunction with the MIMP and the sub plans to EMPLAN.

The following new sub plan to the MIMP has been published on the intranet:

• Major Structure Collapse Sub Plan

Key points

The purpose of the Major Structure Collapse Sub Plan is to:

- Ensure that FRNSW provides an effective response to major structure collapses in NSW under the coordination of the Emergency Operations Controller.
- Ensure FRNSW meets its obligations under the NSW <u>Major Structure Collapse Sub</u> <u>Plan</u> to EMPLAN
- Set the context for FRNSW input into Regional and Local Emergency Plans.
