Key points

- These documents are components of the Be Safe Health and Safety Management System (HSMS), which coordinates the management of all health and safety hazards and risks arising from FRNSW undertakings.
- The policy and procedure documents support an AS31000:2018 (Aust. Risk Management Standard) aligned framework for the management of health and safety risks across the organisation; supporting a proactive, coordinated and effective approach to the management of health and safety risk.
- Existing risk management policy and processes have been incorporated into the new FRNSW procedure format. Additional requirements focus on developing strategic level risk processes with an emphasis of providing relevant risk information to senior officers; and ensuring decisions made on significant health and safety risks align with the legal standard of 'reasonably practicable' (as required by the *Work Health and Safety Act 2011*).

All staff and those affected by FRNSW activities, including Permanent Firefighters, Retained Firefighters, administrative and trades staff, volunteers, contractors and visitors to FRNSW workplaces.

Aviation Emergency Sub Plan to the Major Incident Management Plan

FRNSW's <u>Major Incident Management Plan</u> (MIMP) ensures that FRNSW provides effective, coordinated response to major incidents in NSW in support of the <u>State Emergency</u> <u>Management Plan</u> (EMPLAN).

Sub plans to the MIMP detail requirements for dealing with specific types of incidents and should be read in conjunction with the MIMP and the sub plans to EMPLAN.

Key points

The purpose of the Aviation Emergency Sub Plan is to:

- ensure that FRNSW provides an effective response to aviation emergencies under the coordination of the Emergency Operations Controller
- Ensure FRNSW meets its obligations under the NSW <u>Aviation Emergency Sub Plan</u> to EMPLAN
- Set the context for FRNSW input into Regional, Local and Airport Emergency Plans.
