Hazardous material incidents charging policy

The Hazardous Material Incidents Charging Policy gives the key principles for Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) charges for services at hazardous material (hazmat) incidents under Section 40(4A) of the Fire and Rescue NSW Act 1989. The policy applies to all hazmat incidents in NSW attended by FRNSW.

The Hazardous Material Incidents Charging Policy has been updated, approved, and can be found published on the intranet. The Policy is supported by the Hazmat Charging Toolkit and the Hazardous Materials Incident Charge Procedure which are also on the intranet - http://intranet.nswfire.nsw.gov.au/toolkit/operational/hazmat/hazmat-charging

Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus Training policy

This <u>Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus Training policy</u> is published on the intranet and it describes how FRNSW manages accreditation and ongoing skills maintenance for self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). SCBA skills are managed in order to:

- Establish best practice for accreditation and subsequent operation, maintenance, and safe use of SCBA
- Maintain ongoing and complying proficiency standards for gualified SCBA operators
- Mitigate skill deterioration and the consequent growth of SCBA operations safety risks.

Key points

- The implementation plan for the new three-year SCBA policy has been determined:
 - a. firefighters who have successfully completed a BA recertification in the last 18 months, are given an expiry date 3 years after the implementation date of the Policy; and
 - b. firefighters who have not successfully completed a BA recertification in the last 18 months will retain their existing BA recertification expiry date. Upon completion of skills maintenance with an Education and Training - Training Officer, recertification expiry date will reflect 3 years from completion of that training.
