PROCEDURES

Recommended practice, PPE: Duty wear shirts and trousers

[Recommended practice, PPE: Duty wear shirts and trousers](#) (Version 01) has been published on the [Equipment recommended practices](#) toolkit on the intranet.

This recommended practice guides firefighters in the correct use of duty wear shirts and trousers.

There is no change in the operational use of duty wear. Requirements are listed in both the new recommended practice and in Section 6 of [Recommended practice, Protective clothing, equipment and uniform](#).

Duty wear rollout key points

- Due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on supply chains, further availability of new duty wear will be limited until the 4th quarter 2020.
- Firefighters must keep at least 2 sets of their old duty wear to use as a backup if their new duty wear is unavailable due to contamination or is in the laundry.
- Firefighters should keep their existing polar fleece jackets, round neck jumper, sunhat and beanies to wear until the new items are available on ESCAT in the 4th quarter 2020.
- Supporting information such as checking the fit of new garments, exchanging garments and a series of FAQs of when and how to wear garments has been published on the [Roll out of new PPE](#) toolkit.
- Further rollout information will be provided on the [Roll out of new PPE](#) toolkit as it becomes available.

Rollout of new telephone numbers in Fire and Rescue NSW

IP telephones have been rolled out at larger sites in FRNSW i.e. Greenacre, Alexandria, Orchard Hills, City of Sydney, Pyrmont, Area and Zone Offices. With the rollout of IP telephones, Area and Zone Offices have new telephone numbers and these are available on the online phonebook. The old numbers are still in operation however they will be disconnected soon.

Commencing in 2020, IP telephones will be rolled out at Fire Stations. The full business number for Fire Stations will be changed to a new simplified format. Any Fire Station can be reached by calling **9493 1 + the three-digit station number** e.g. Station 017 can be reached by calling **9493 1017**. The old business number will continue to work for at least six months.

When IP telephones are installed at a station, the internal dialling number will remain the same. Internal dialling number is also commonly referred to as FireNET number and also as PAX number. For any Fire Station the internal dialling number is 5 + the three-digit station number e.g. Station 017 is **5017**.

Fire Station new business number and FireNET (PAX) examples:

Fire Stations outside Sydney will have an additional (local) number corresponding to their STD area. Each Station will be advised of their local number when they are migrated to IP Phones.
