The <u>Enterprise Risk Management Guidelines</u> are published on the <u>Risk Management Toolkit</u> and the intranet. These Guidelines support the FRNSW Risk Management Framework in the Risk Management Policy.

#### **Key points**

The Enterprise Risk Management Guidelines provide guidance:

- In the identification, evaluation, and classification of risks in order to develop strategies to mitigate and reduce risk to the organisation.
- On when and why staff members must manage risks as part of any strategic, operational, and project-based activity, and to help inform decisions and prioritise actions.
- On the development of risk registers to identify and manage the uncertainties that could impact the achievement of objectives.

#### Who needs to read the plan?

All staff involved in the process of identifying, assessing, and managing enterprise risks in their own area, or at a strategic level.

#### **Key points**

This version of the Delegations Manual includes the following new and amended delegations:

- to authorise the recovery of debts through a contracted debt recovery agency (3.4)
- an administrative delegation to undertake internal privacy reviews (16.8)
- an administrative delegation for the signing of memorandums of understanding (16.9), and
- the authority to apply for and maintain environmental licensing requirements for the FRNSW Emergency Services Academy (16.10).
- additional delegates to determine and undertake internal reviews of Government Information Public Access applications
- additional delegates to extend firefighter probation periods, and
- reduce red tape on intrastate travel approvals to/from Canberra, Mildura, and Gold Coast airports
