# **Key points**

The <u>Corporate Sponsorship Policy</u> outlines FRNSW approach to dealing with sponsorship and details the types of sponsorship arrangements FRNSW will undertake. The <u>Corporate Sponsorship Procedures</u> stipulates the requirements for engaging in such arrangements.

FRNSW has a range of responsibilities to deliver programs and services to the community. By seeking and receiving sponsorship, FRNSW provides additional resources with which to support specific activities or programs. In addition, the success and public exposure of an activity can be enhanced by sponsorship providing better engagement by the community.

# **Cultural Fire Management Policy**

The <u>Cultural fire management policy</u> has been published on the <u>Hazard reduction</u> toolkit on the intranet.

# **Key points**

FRNSW recognises the importance of working with Indigenous Land Managers and with Local Government in FRNSW Fire Districts to undertake cultural burning activities by cultural fire management.

This policy recognises that cultural burning activities or cultural fire management is deemed to be of cultural significance to the Indigenous community. All preparation works for cultural burning activities are the responsibility of the relevant land managers and relates to those activities being conducted in FRNSW fire districts.

Indigenous communities are custodians of their culture and Country, and the purpose of this policy is to assist Indigenous communities to conduct traditional fire management practices.

This policy needs to be read by all firefighters involved with cultural burning activities.

# **TOBAN Exemptions**

<u>The Total Fire Ban and Exemptions toolkit</u> provides a simple updated reference for exemption notification. The TOBAN exemption is a notification not an application process that would not benefit from a formal policy/procedure.

# **Key points**

- To reduce the risk of fires damaging or destroying life, property, and the environment the NSW RFS Commissioner may declare a Total Fire Ban (TOBAN). Total Fire Ban declarations are usually made in the afternoon for the following day and usually start at midnight and last for 24 hours. A TOBAN may be issued on the actual day if weather conditions get worse
- The existing In Orders do not prescribe the current procedures for receiving, reviewing, and replying to TOBAN exemption requests.

## Who needs to read the plan?

All staff involved with TOBAN exemptions requests.

- In Orders 2006/28, <u>Consultation on total fire ban exemptions</u> (Schedule 18, any other fire approved by NSW RFS Commissioner).
