Interagency radio communications

The Interagency ESO GRN Talkgroup, ESO Simplex and Government Liaison GRN Talkgroup Conversion chart has been updated and is available on the Operational Communication toolkit. It will also be available on MDTs and Adashi C&C once the guidance has been updated.

Key points

Coordination of resources at multi-agency incidents is crucial for safe and effective operations. It is particularly important when working with other agencies at bushfires. The updated chart includes details of the channels and talkgroups for all NSW emergency services, Queensland Fire Service, and the ACT Emergency Services Authority.

- Reference to new laundry procedures.

<u>SIMS worksheet – Firefighting and duty wear</u> (Version 08)

Use this worksheet as soon as your station migrates to the new XFlex structural firefighting clothing. This worksheet includes:

- New duty wear.
- Stowage and inspection of P3 respiratory protection filters issued to firefighters.
- Reference to new laundry procedures.
- New Pelican firefighting torch.

<u>SIMS worksheet – Appliance IT and comms equipment</u> (Version 01)

- New daily worksheet covering the required checks for IT and radio equipment installed on the appliance, including the GRN radio, mobile phones, mobile data terminal, AVL, and other items.
- Some of these checks have been transferred from SIMS worksheet, Appliance –
 Major Fleet. Operators should use this sheet for those checks. Equipment does not
 need to be checked twice.

2020-2021 Christmas/New Year Period

The NSW Department of Premier & Cabinet's Memorandum M2019-03 issued on 14 October 2019, advises NSW public sector agencies about public holidays and service delivery requirements for the three years 2019-2022.

The 2020 -2021 Christmas closedown period is from Friday 25 December 2020 – Friday 8 January 2021 inclusive.

All Administrative/Trades staff are encouraged to maximise the use of Recreational or Flex leave, wherever possible, ensuring front line services are maintained. Staff with excessive leave balances may be directed to take leave during this period. Managers must coordinate with their staff to ensure leave is maximised during this period.

Public Service Holiday

The Public Service Holiday for Fire & Rescue NSW has been determined by the Commissioner as Tuesday 29 December 2020.

Staff who are directed to work on that day are entitled to be absent from duty on one of the other working days between Boxing Day and New Year's Day without loss of pay.

Where staff are directed to work on all the working days between Boxing Day and New Year's Day they are entitled to be paid overtime at the 'Public Holiday' rate for work performed on the Public Service Holiday, Tuesday 29 December 2020.

Part time employees are entitled to be absent on the Public Service Holiday and receive ordinary pay if they would normally have worked on that day. Those who do not normally work on that day are not entitled to compensation.

Concessional Leave

For employees required to work during the closedown period and subject to industrial instruments and FRNSW's operational and staffing requirements, concessional leave will be available to eligible employees for the afternoon of 24 December 2020 (Christmas Eve).

To be eligible for concessional leave, employees must be required to be on duty that morning and must work half the standard full-time daily hours for the employee's category of employment.

Eligible employees who are directed to remain on duty for the full day on Christmas Eve are entitled to a half-day's concessional leave on the afternoon of 31 December 2020 (New Year's Eve).

Provisions for the granting and taking of concessional leave are set out in the *Public Service Industrial Relations Guide*, 6.4 Concessional Leave.
