PROCEDURES

SIMS rollover for 2021

SIMS calendars for 2021 have been developed and published to the <u>SIMS calendars</u> toolkit on the Intranet.

Who needs to read this instruction?

All firefighters and all Zone and Area Command staff.

Procedure for SIMS calendars

Hardcopies of SIMS calendars will be distributed to fire stations and to Zone offices for Duty Commanders. Alternatively, all SIMS calendars can be found on the <u>SIMS calendar</u> toolkit.

On 1st January 2021, SIMS calendars for 2020 should be removed from the SIMS board, or SIMS folder for those appliances that have one, and filed. SIMS calendars for 2021 should then be loaded into the SIMS board or folder.

Old SIMS calendars and other completed documents such as Defect Report sheets must be filed in the station for a period of seven years. Duty Commanders should file old SIMS calendars according to <u>Work instruction, SIMS for operational minor fleet.</u> For more information, refer to the <u>Records Management Policy</u> and the procedures on the <u>Records management</u> toolkit.

New SIMS worksheets

SIMS worksheets for equipment have been revised both to help manage contamination in the workplace and as part of a general update of SIMS. These have been published on the <u>SIMS equipment worksheets</u> toolkit. Revised SIMS worksheets are:

- SIMS worksheet, <u>Cabin inventory check</u> (Version 07). Highlights:
 - o <u>Confined space risk assessment and entry</u> form added to the inventory
 - Listing of the Air Traffic Safety Bureau's <u>Hazards at aviation accident sites</u> updated.
- SIMS worksheet, <u>Portable radios: Motorola APX 8000XE and APX 8000HXE</u> (Version 02). Highlights:
 - Deletion of mention of a non-incendive hazardous location certification of the 8000XE radio.
 - o Requirement to dispose of damaged Li-ion batteries locally.
- SIMS worksheet, <u>Multi-head gas detector Altair 5X family (rechargeable) with GX2</u> (Version 02). Highlights:
 - Addition of calibration gas listings on ESCAT.
 - Addition of <u>Australian Dangerous Goods Code</u> transport requirements for lithiumion batteries.

Procedure for SIMS worksheets

Paper copies of all SIMS worksheets revised during the year are being distributed with SIMS calendars. As soon as you receive new SIMS worksheets relevant to your appliance:

- Remove the old worksheets from the station SIMS board or folder.
- Replace them with the new worksheets.
- Old SIMS worksheets should be disposed of.

If you are missing any of the required worksheets for your appliance, download them from the <u>SIMS equipment worksheets</u> toolkit, print them out, and post them on your SIMS board.
