NOTICES

Expressions of interest for NRSC overseas bushfire deployment

Expressions of Interest (EOI) are being sought from FRNSW permanent firefighters wishing to be considered for overseas bushfire deployment in 2024/5. FRNSW is committed to being operationally ready ahead of any potential request for assistance for Australian personnel, including for our staff.

How to apply

The National Resource Sharing Centre (NRSC) co-ordinates requests for assistance from overseas firefighting agencies. Such requests are actioned with the co-operation of Australian and New Zealand fire services.

All interested permanent firefighters are requested to either re-register their existing profile, or create a new profile in NRSC' Overseas Deployment Registry https://nrsc.afac.com.au/:

- Please do not create a duplicate profile using another email address.
- If you have forgotten your password, there is the option to reset it.
- If you wish to be deleted from the register, there is no action required as NRSC will annually delete personal data stored in the NRSC International Deployment Register.

Each EOI will be assessed and validated in preparation for potential deployment. Importantly, once your EOI is submitted it remains locked until the Overseas Deployment Team has finalised your application.

Who can apply

Personnel with formal qualifications, skills, and bushfire experience commensurate with the roles being applied for will be assessed by a panel of representatives from Operational Staffing, Operational Capability, and Education and Training prior to an application being validated and the applicant being endorsed to deploy. Validation of skills will be via review of an applicant's ESS training record.

Conditions

A number of conditions need to be met to ensure the safety of our members while overseas.

Vaccination Requirements

In order to be considered eligible for deployment personnel must, unless stipulated otherwise by the National Resource Sharing Centre, demonstrate compliance with the <u>FRNSW Vaccination and Screening Policy</u> as it relates to their ordinary employment category.

Health Assessment

To be eligible for deployment personnel must have completed (within the last 5 years), a FRNSW Health Check or Health Screen conducted by or overseen by an Occupational Physician. Health Screens conducted by a Nominated Medical Practitioner can, with consent, be provided to the FRNSW Health Check Coordinator to be overseen by the FRNSW Occupational Physician. Fitness

Personnel nominating for field-based roles of operations officer, field officer, safety officer etc are required to:

- be certified fit for the operational duties performed by FRNSW firefighters without any restrictions.
- successfully pass the arduous pack test (APT) required of wildland firefighters in North America: Personnel must walk 4.83km carrying 20.4kg in 45 minutes or under. If participants weigh less than 68kg they can carry 15.4kg.

All personnel nominating for incident management team or administrative roles (with the exception of the operations officer) will need to:

- be certified fit for their ordinary duties within FRNSW without any restrictions.
- successfully complete the field walk test: Personnel must walk 1.6 km on level ground without additional weight, in 16 minutes or under.

If personnel have undertaken an arduous level medical (or equivalent), they will be offered the opportunity to complete the arduous pack test regardless of their nominated role. This will allow them greater flexibility to fulfil other roles while overseas. Please note the APT is demanding and is suitable only for those who are active or have prepared.

Fitness assessments will be conducted at the time of deployment.

Actions to undertake now

In addition to updating or creating your profile, please ensure:

- your passport is up to date, with at least six (6) months until expiry.
- your medical (health check) and any required vaccination status is up to date.

What happens next

Your application will go through a review process to validate your qualifications, experience, and suitability, prior to endorsement by Assistant Commissioner Operational Capability.

If your application has previously been approved and your details are current, it remains valid. Please check that all your details in the NRSC deployment registry are still correct including emergency contacts. If you update or increase the roles that you are applying for, the same review process as above will be triggered.

It is your responsibility to continue to maintain your deployable status, by ensuring that you keep your details up to date, should your circumstances change.

Eligibility for a deployment will be determined at the time that a request for assistance is received. Accepting your application does not guarantee your deployment, as each request is specific to the circumstances and needs of the requesting country.

However, it is equally important that FRNSW maintains a register of validated and approved personnel in a wide range of roles in preparation for the short time frames involved in coordinating an overseas deployment.
