TRAINING

Operational Firefighter Driver Training.

This instruction rescinds Commissioners Orders 2003/26 'Qualifications for operating NSWFB appliances'

Permanent Firefighters

As part of the initial training program, all permanent firefighters are trained to drive FRNSW heavy vehicles and are provided a sound understanding of FRNSW policies, procedures, and legislation related to driving and responding under emergency conditions. The training also awards the national Unit of Competency 'Drive vehicles under operational conditions'

After completing initial training, firefighters must record 35 hours of driving hours and 10 hours of pump operations in the six months following initial training, which includes conducting appliance <u>SIMS</u> checks. A minimum of five hours of this component will include night driving to gain expertise as heavy vehicle drivers and become familiar with their appliance and station area before driving under response conditions.

The <u>Driving Hours Log for Permanent Firefighters</u> is available in the Learning Station and must be completed after each drive or training session. Each entry must be at least 15 minutes to count towards your total time and tasks must be verified and signed by your Station Commander.

At the completion of the required hours, the driving log is submitted through the Learning Station for qualifications to be updated and the firefighter will receive an automated response, notifying them they can drive under response conditions.

Retained firefighters

Retained firefighters undergo driver training on an as-needed basis, determined by the Zone Commander. Retained Firefighters identified to become motor drivers, able to respond under response conditions will make applications through their respective Zone commands

Licence upgrades to the appropriate license are generally provided through local providers coordinated by Zone Management. All Transport for NSW requirements apply for medium rigid licences. The Appliance Training Unit (ATU) may assist zones with licence upgrades, depending on the availability of qualified heavy vehicle assessors within the training unit.

Regional training conducts pump schools. These are held regularly in each Zone on as asneeded basis.

The following procedure will apply to all Retained Firefighters when making applications for driver training:

- Once an application is approved by the Zone Commander, the applicant will undertake a license upgrade through local vendors or ATU.
- When an applicant holds an MR licence, the application will be forwarded to Regional Training.
- Regional Training will schedule pump school in consultation with Zone management and firefighters will be allocated to training by Zone Management.

- The applicant will complete pump school by Regional Training which includes training on the appliance types. Should the training appliance differ from the appliance at the firefighter's respective station, Regional Training will train the applicant on the appliance type at the applicant's station as soon as practicable.
- After completing initial training, retained firefighters must record 10 hours of driving hours and 5 hours of pump operations following pump school. A minimum of two hours of this component will include night driving.
- The <u>Driving and Pump Hours Log for Retained Firefighters</u> is available in the Learning Station and completed after each drive or training session. Each entry must be a minimum of 15 minutes to count towards your total time and tasks must be verified and signed by the officer in charge. Once complete the Station Management Team (SMT) on the recommendation of the Station Commander, will deem the candidates' hours to be complete.

On completion of the required hours, the driving log is submitted through the Learning Station for qualifications to be updated and the firefighter will receive an automated response, notifying them they can drive under response conditions.

Overt Video Surveillance

As per In Order 2006-13 Overt Video Surveillance has been installed at Orange Fire Station. The installation was done as a deterrent to inappropriate interactions with firefighters, and to capture any criminal activity outside Orange Fire Station. The cameras cover the front, side and rear access to the fire station including the rear yard. No internal spaces are covered by these cameras and recording does not include any audio capability.

The capability is intended to be switch on from 0800 hrs on October 9th, 2024 on an ongoing basis.

Any footage will only be used by NSW Police to identify any criminal activity in the area. Signage advising employees and members of the public that the area is under video surveillance is displayed at the front and rear entrances to the Station. Consultation with all staff at Orange occurred prior to the installation.
