Fuel and oil purchasing and use

A revised policy on <u>Fuel and oil purchasing and use</u> has been published on the <u>Administration Policies</u> page of the intranet.

Introduction of security code numbers for fuel cards

The fuel and oil suppliers on the NSW Government contract are introducing security code numbers for fuel cards. The introduction of the security code numbers commenced in July 2013.

Fleet Management will progressively issue the security codes for all fuel cards. Vehicle users will receive a letter informing them of the security code for their card. If you have been issued with a security code number for a fuel card, you must enter the security code number when using the card.

This policy needs to be read by all staff who purchase or use fuel and oil in the course of their duties.

This policy rescinds Commissioner's Orders 2012/17, Fuel and oil policy.
