At a recent incident the starter cord on a power saw failed, resulting in a delay to operations. To mitigate the risk of this occurring again, an inspection of the starter cord has been added to the SIMS worksheets for all equipment with recoil starters.

Equipment Quarantine

All firefighters are reminded of the correct equipment quarantine procedures posted on the [Equipment quarantine](#) toolkit, supported by [In Orders 2008/18, 'Equipment malfunctions and quarantine procedures'](#).

When an item of equipment malfunctions at training or an incident, or if equipment is implicated in an injury or near miss, it must be quarantined for investigation by the Equipment Management Unit and Health Safety Branch.

Self-contained breathing apparatus is quarantined in the same manner as all other equipment. Turn the cylinder off, but do not disconnect it. Remove the distress signal unit unless it is implicated in the incident. Contact [Equipment Logistics Hazmat](#) on 9709 4335 for advice on transporting the air cylinder.

Quarantine bags, pouches and security tags are available to Duty Commanders on ESCAT. Where an injury or near miss has occurred, the [Management and investigation of safety incidents](#) policy and procedures must be followed, and a Notification of Injury, Illness, Exposure or Near Miss report initiated using the [online NIIENM system](#).

If equipment malfunctions during equipment inspections or preoperational checks such as SIMS, the officer in charge should contact the functional area responsible for the equipment and arrange for it to be repaired.

Transfers to the GSA

This Commissioner's Order details how permanent firefighters and officers up to and including the rank of Inspector who are attached to a station/workplace outside of the GSA are transferred to the GSA.

This Commissioner's Order rescinds and replaces In-Order 2006/2 titled *Appointment Guidelines for the allocation of unfilled Country Station Officer and Inspector positions*.

Occupants of Operational Support positions and Special Roster Relieving Inspectors shall be considered to be attached to a station/workplace outside of the GSA for the purposes of this Commissioner's Order.

Placement within the GSA will be according to operational and management needs as determined by the Superintendent Operational Staffing.

This Commissioner's Order in no way limits the provisions of Clause 26 (3) of the *Fire Brigades (General) Regulation 2014*.

Firefighters

1. Firefighters who are attached to a station/workplace outside of the GSA and who request a transfer to the GSA shall be released from their current position within six (6) months of such request and transferred, provided that a firefighter who:
 - a. Was initially appointed to a station outside of the GSA as the result of local retained to permanent recruitment shall not be eligible to request a transfer to the GSA before they have completed at least 24 months service at that station.

- b. Successfully applies for a Station Officer vacancy in the GSA pursuant to Award subclause 13.8 shall be transferred to the GSA upon successful completion of the Station Officer Program and promotion to Station Officer.
- c. Was appointed to a Country Officer position pursuant to Award subclause 7.5.2 and who ceases to be eligible for promotion pursuant to Award subclause 13.8.2 shall be transferred to the GSA.
- d. Is the occupant of an Operational Support position shall be released from their current position and transferred with 28 days' notice pursuant to Award subclause 14.10.

Officers and Senior Officers

- 2. Officers and Senior Officers who are attached to a station/workplace outside of the GSA may be transferred to the GSA:
 - a. In the case of Leading Station Officers and Station Officers, by merit selection for all Station Officer vacancies which occur in the GSA, which shall be advertised in Commissioner's Orders and for which all such employees shall be eligible to apply together with all Leading Firefighters pursuant to Award subclause 13.8; or
 - b. In the case of Inspectors and Leading Station Officers, by merit selection for all Special Roster Relieving Inspector vacancies which are advertised as such in Commissioner's Orders and for which all such employees shall be eligible to apply together with all Inspectors and Leading Station Officers in the GSA pursuant to subclause 13.10; or
 - c. In the case of Inspectors and Leading Station Officers, by merit selection for all Inspector vacancies which occur in the GSA, which shall be advertised in Commissioner's Orders and for which all such employees shall be eligible to apply together with Leading Station Officers in the GSA pursuant to Award subclause 13.10; or
 - d. In the case of Inspectors, by merit selection for all Superintendent or Chief Superintendent vacancies which occur in the GSA, which shall be advertised in Commissioner's Orders and for which all such employees shall be eligible to apply together with all Inspectors in the GSA pursuant to Award subclause 13.11, and with all Inspectors and Superintendents in the GSA pursuant to Award subclause 13.12; or
 - e. In the case of Leading Station Officers and Station Officers appointed to Country Senior Officer or Operational Support Inspector positions pursuant to Award subclauses 28.7.3 or 28.7.4, by mandatory transfer pursuant to Award subclauses 7.5.3 or 7.5.4; or
 - f. In the case of employees attached to a station/workplace within a Regional Transfer Register area for their rank, upon request, in which case an employee shall be released from their current position within six (6) months of such request and transferred; or

- g. In the case of employees attached to a station/workplace for which there is no Regional Transfer Register for their rank, upon request following the completion of not less than 24 months from the date of appointment to that position, in which case an employee shall be released from their current position within 6 months and transferred unless they are the occupant of an Operational Support position, in which case the 24 months service requirement shall apply to Operational Support Inspectors only and an employee shall be released and transferred with 28 days' notice.
3. Officers and Senior Officers appointed to their current position on or after 24 April 2018 (or in the case of Operational Support Inspectors only, on or after 14 November 2014) who request transfer pursuant to point 2g of this Commissioner's Order shall be transferred to the GSA:
- a. In the case of Inspectors, at the rank of Leading Station Officer.
 - b. In the case of Leading Station Officers, at the rank of Station Officer unless they are the occupant of an Operational Support position, in which case they shall be released and remain at Leading Station Officer rank.
 - c. In the case of Station Officers, at the rank of Leading Firefighter unless they are the occupant of an Operational Support position, in which case they shall be released and remain at Station Officer rank.
