## New recommended practice - Bulk water transfer system

Recommended practice, Bulk water transfer system – Hytrans (Version 01) has been published on the Bulk water transfer system toolkit.

This recommended practice guides operators in the correct operation of the Hytrans bulk water transfer system. Highlights include:

- Accessing water, including from mains.
- Using squeeze ramps to lay hose across intersections.
- Using hydraulic hose quick connects to aid in the recovery of the pump unit.
- Inventory and stowage.
