New recommended practice – Bulk water transfer system

Recommended practice, Bulk water transfer system – Hytrans (Version 01) has been published on the [Bulk water transfer system](#) toolkit.

This recommended practice guides operators in the correct operation of the Hytrans bulk water transfer system. Highlights include:

- Accessing water, including from mains.
- Using squeeze ramps to lay hose across intersections.
- Using hydraulic hose quick connects to aid in the recovery of the pump unit.
- Inventory and stowage.
