Dignitary Protection Operations Policy

When requested, FRNSW provides assistance to NSW Police Force (NSWPF) and other law enforcement jurisdictions during an Internationally Protected People (IPP) visit to NSW. The Dignitary Protection Operations Policy defines FRNSW capability to provide hazmat detection and decontamination.

The following documents provide framework to support Dignitary Protection Operations:

- Major Incident Management Plans
- Standard Operational Guidelines Section 1 Incident management
- Standard Operational Guidelines Section 8 Special incidents
- Standard Operational Guidelines Section 10 Hazardous materials

- How a request to assist NSWPF is received and approved
- When, where and how the policy is applied
- Roles and responsibilities of FNSW staff involved in the protection of IPP
- Procedures to be followed by FRNSW staff whilst participating in the protection of IPP
- Specialist training requirements for FRNSW staff participating in the protection of IPP

PROCEDURES

New SCBA training videos for the Station Training Program

Who needs to read this?

All firefighters, and all staff responsible for managing the Station Training Program in fire stations and Zone and Area offices.

Issue

The Station Drill videos for Station Training Program, Group A, Topic 4- 'Self-Contained breathing apparatus' have been remade for MSA AirGo SCBA. The new videos include safety modifications such as the new method of fastening the cylinder strap which was developed in consultation with FRNSW firefighters, and the correct placement of your radio boom microphone.

Three new videos have been added to the series to cover changing a cylinder, decontaminating SCBA at an incident, and the negative pressure fit test for an SCBA facemask.

The new videos are:

- Video, Standard drill 12 Functional SCBA and DSU checks
- Video, Standard drill 13 Preoperational SCBA checks
- Video, Standard drill 14 Donning and doffing SCBA
- Video, <u>Standard drill 15 BA control system</u> (unchanged)
- Video, Standard drill 16 Disinfecting SCBA facemasks
- Video, Standard drill 17 Changing an SCBA cylinder (new video)
- Video, Standard drill 18 SCBA decontamination (new video)
- Video, <u>Standard drill 19 Negative pressure fit check for an SCBA facemask</u> (new video).

Actions

All firefighters must report any SCBA sets that have not been modified as shown in these videos through their chain of command to Equipment Logistics Hazmat.

Station Commanders must incorporate these videos into their station training for SCBA. All firefighters must:

- Immediately view the video, <u>Standard drill 13 Preoperational SCBA checks</u>, paying attention to the new method of fastening a cylinder strap.
- Must use the new method of fastening a cylinder strap as part of their functional and preoperational checks of SCBA, as documented in <u>SIMS worksheet</u>, <u>SCBA</u> and required by
 SOG 9.2, Breathing apparatus safe working practices.
- Incorporate these videos in their station training for SCBA.
