## PROCEDURES

## **New EMT packs**

#### Who needs to read this instruction?

All people responsible for using and maintaining Emergency Medical Treatment (EMT) packs.

#### Rollout of new first aid equipment

A range of new first aid equipment is being issued for inclusion in the Trauma kit of all EMT packs. This equipment has been introduced following observations from firefighters. This equipment includes:

- Bleeding kit.
- Snake bite bandage
- Face shield burn dressing
- Vomit bags
- Observations notepad (for recording observations for medical handover.

The above items have been distributed to stations. On receipt, items should be installed in the trauma kit of EMT packs. If any station does not receive any of the above items, they should be ordered on ESCAT using the details on the SIMS worksheets. Resupply of all items is through ESCAT.

In addition, the following items have been added to the inventory of trauma packs:

- 1 x pack 20 occlusive bandages (ESCAT 10385)
- 1 x pack 20 assorted size bandages (ESCAT 10386)
- 1 x permanent marker (ESCAT 08242)

All stations with EMT packs should order these items on ESCAT and stow them in the trauma kit. The inventory of EMT packs has been revised and all stations should align the inventory with that listed on the latest editions of the SIMS worksheets.

#### Rollout of the new EMT pack

New style EMT packs are being distributed to fire stations in a staged rollout over the next couple of financial years. The new EMT packs are easier to clean and decontaminate; and will fit in the same stowage locations on your appliance.

When your station receives a new EMT pack:

- Transfer all first aid equipment from your old pack to the new pack.
- Regional stations should either stow the old EMT pack at the station for emergency use or dispose of by removing and cutting up the branding and then disposing of in the council waste stream.
- Metro stations should return old EMT packs to Hazmat Logistics using Logistics Support Vehicles.
- Download and use the <u>SIMS worksheet</u> for the new EMT pack.

An instruction letter has been included with the new EMT pack. For more information, see the introductory video <u>New EMT pack</u>.

## **New SIMS worksheets for EMT packs**

SIMS worksheets for EMT packs have been revised and posted on the <u>SIMS equipment</u> worksheets toolkit.

- If your station is using the old blue EMT pack, download and use <u>SIMS worksheet</u>, <u>Emergency Medical Treatment Pack Old</u> (Version 07).
- If your station has been sent the new EMT pack, download and use <u>SIMS worksheet</u>, <u>Emergency Medical Treatment pack</u> (Version 01)

SIMS worksheet, Emergency Medical Treatment Pack (Version 06) is rescinded. Station Commanders must arrange for this worksheet to be removed from the SIMS board and replaced by the relevant new SIMS worksheet.
