Investigate a fire

The following documents have been published on the intranet:

• SOG 4.7 Investigate a fire (Version 01) and check sheet (Version 01)

The SOG provides information about how to conduct a fire investigation.

It is supported by the <u>Fire Investigation Field Guide</u>, which is available on the <u>Fire</u> <u>Investigation guides and resources</u> intranet pages.

Key points

- Every fire that FRNSW attends must be investigated to determine its cause and origin. The Incident Commander is responsible for investigating and reporting the findings of the investigation.
- FRNSW's on-call fire investigators in the Fire Investigation and Research Unit (FIRU) can provide expert assistance if requested. They can assist also if cause and origin cannot be determined.
- A systematic approach to the fire investigation ensures that conclusions are sound and evidence based.

What needs to be done?

Station Commanders must ensure that all crews are aware of the contents of the SOGs. All operational staff must sign off the SOGs – station staff sign off in the Station Planning System (SPS); operational staff not attached to a station sign off in Employee Self Service (ESS).

Long service leave ballot applications 2022/2023

Call for applications

In accordance with Procedure – *Long service leave quotas for permanent firefighters during peak holiday periods and special events,* long service leave applications for periods that fall in peak holiday periods in 2022/2023 are now called for from Inspectors, Station Officers and Firefighters.

Dates of peak periods

The following dates for the year 2022/2023 are classified as peak periods and are subject to the procedures described in In Orders 1998/19:

- Autumn school holidays 09 April to 23 April 2022
- Winter school holidays 02 July to 16 July 2022
- Spring school holidays 24 September to 09 October 2022
- Summer school holidays 17 December 2022 to 28 January 2023
- Australasian Firefighter and Emergency Services Games 04 March 2022 to 12 March 2022
- World Firefighters Games 18 July to 06 August 2022 (this includes travel time)

Exemptions from ballot

The ballot system and the related six week application period for peak periods does not apply to firefighters who are seeking extended periods of long service leave. For the purposes of this procedure 'extended' means any period in excess of two consecutive months on full pay or four consecutive months on half pay.

Closing date for applications

<u>Long service leave application forms</u> are available on the Station Portal and are to be submitted to your Zone Commander or Manager.
