POLICIES

Purchasing Card (PCard) Policy and Procedures

The updated <u>Purchasing Card Policy</u> and Purchasing Card Procedures have been published on the <u>Finance</u> toolkit on the intranet.

Key points

The Purchasing Card Policy addresses the responsibility for the proper management and administration of purchasing cards (PCard) within FRNSW and the responsibilities of the cardholders. The transaction limits have been aligned with Treasury Policy Paper 21-02 *Use and Management of NSW Government Purchasing Cards*.

The procedure provides guidelines on the internal approval process to obtain, use and manage Purchasing Card (PCard) issued to eligible employees.

PCards are issued to provide a payment facility to enable the secure purchase of goods and services in support of legitimate business expenses.

Who needs to read the plan?

The policy and procedure need to be read by all FRNSW employees issued with a PCard and those charged with authorising the issuance of a PCard and approving PCard transactions.
