# **Enterprise Risk Management Policy, Framework and Guidelines**

The new <u>Enterprise Risk Management Policy</u> and updated <u>Enterprise Risk Management Framework</u> and <u>Enterprise Risk Management Guidelines</u> have been published on the intranet.

### **Key points**

The FRNSW Policy, Framework and Guidelines have been updated in line with Treasury Policy TPP20-08, including:

- Greater emphasis on the role of leadership in risk management
- Expanded risk management principles
- The addition of Climate and Environment Risk and Cybersecurity Risk categories.

The Strategy and Risk team within the Strategy, Planning and Performance Branch will work with leaders, managers, and risk champions to implement these changes.

A further review of the Enterprise Risk Management Framework will occur later in 2022. This will occur in consultation with leaders, managers, and employees to ensure the framework remains fit for purpose and is consistent with Fire and Rescue NSW objectives.

The purpose of the policy is to Inform all employees and others who have access to Fire and Rescue NSW (FRNSW) information systems about their cyber security related obligations and responsibilities.

The Policy applies to all FRNSW staff (staff includes permanent and retained fire fighters, administrative and technical staff, contractors and consultants), partnering government agency employees, service providers, volunteers and visitors.

## **Bushfire Sub plan to the Major Incident Management Plan**

The <u>Bushfire Sub Plan</u> to the Major Incident Management Plan has been reviewed and the revised Version 04 has been published on the <u>Major Incident Management Plans</u> toolkit on the intranet.

### **Key points**

The Bushfire Sub Plan ensures that FRNSW provides effective, coordinated response to major incidents in NSW in support of the <u>NSW State Bushfire Plan</u> (EMPLAN).

The revisions in Version 04 include:

- Major revision of the Bushfire Information Coordination Centre (BICC) activation levels
- BICC roles and responsibilities updated
- requirement to ensure that appliances deployed to bushfires are suitable for the task in accordance with Operations Bulletin 2020-08, <u>Appliances suitable for bush/grass</u> <u>fires</u>
- Inclusion of section on AFA activations due to low air quality
- Inclusion of additional information on the responsibilities of Bush Fire Management Committees
- Deletion of table in Appendix B on appliances inappropriate for bushfire strike teams, as coverage of the GSA is managed by the SOC
- Deletion of information about classification and status of bushfires and structure triage that is now in the <u>Guideline Support Document</u> for SOG 3.1, Guidelines for bushfires.
