Work instruction – Using CitroSqueeze

<u>Work instruction – Using CitroSqueeze</u> (Version 01) has been published on the <u>Equipment</u> recommended practices toolkit. This work instruction describes how CitroSqueeze should be used at incidents to according to <u>Guideline support document</u>: SOG 10.4 Decontamination.

Highlights of the work instruction include:

- Safe work practices.
- Procedures for removing gross contamination from PPE on the fireground before it is bagged and sent for laundry, for both small and large incidents.
- Procedure for cleaning equipment on the fireground before stowing on the appliance.

Hydraulics - Double acting tools - Twin hose and CORE (Version 01)

• New worksheet for all double acting hydraulic rescue tools, both twin hose and CORE.

Cabin inventory check (Version 08)

• Revised inventory to include incident safety worksheets.

<u>Hydraulics – PowerShore</u> (Version 01)

• New worksheet for hydraulic shores.

Sharps protection (soft) kit (Version 01)

• New worksheet for the Sharps protection (soft) kit, designed to protect patients and crews from broken glass, severed metal and rescue tools, during motor vehicle extrication.

Memorandum of Understanding with SafeWork NSW

FRNSW and SafeWork NSW have revised the <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u> (MOU) with SafeWork NSW on notification of incidents and matters of interest. The MOU is available on the <u>MOUs page</u> on the intranet.

Key Points

The purpose of the MOU is to facilitate cooperation, coordination and information sharing when responding to matters of interest in a timely and appropriate manner. The main changes in the revised MOU are:

 When Safework requests information, they will now do so via the Information Liaison Officer via email at <u>GIPA@fire.nsw.gov.au</u>

Information sharing is two-way:

- FRNSW Incident Commanders must request FireCOM to notify SafeWork NSW of:
 - work-related fatalities
 - o serious work-related injuries
 - o incidents likely to become high profile and involve multi-agency response
 - major incidents at Major Hazard Facilities that expose or could expose a person to a serious risk to health and safety.
- SafeWork NSW will notify FRNSW:
 - of hazmat incidents, fires or explosions that have not been reported to FRNSW
 - if a Safework Inspector identifies a workplace that manufactures or stores chemicals, has high risk and/or fire loads, and the installed fire protection is turned off or not fully functional.

Who needs to read this MOU?

All Station, Duty and Zone Commanders and FireCOM staff should read the MOU.
