POLICIES

Smoke Free Workplaces Policy

The <u>Smoke Free Workplaces Policy</u> has been revised and republished as Version 3 in the <u>Health Fitness and Wellbeing Element</u> of the Be Safe Safety Management System in the <u>Workplace Safety toolkit</u> on the intranet.

Key points

The revised <u>Smoke Free Workplaces Policy</u> reaffirms FRNSW's commitment to minimising exposure to tobacco smoke and e-cigarette vapours in FRNSW workplaces. The key differences in the revised policy include:

- greater emphasis on non-tobacco smoking products and e-cigarettes,
- greater detail regarding application of the policy in all FRNSW workplaces, including deployments, Base of Operations and other accommodation,
- clarification of the intent of the policy,
- clarification regarding how the policy is to be implemented,
- updated hyperlinks throughout.

Who needs to read the policy?

The policy should be read by all FRNSW workers (including CFU members, contractors and sub-contractors), particularly those with responsibility for workplace WHS inductions and those with management and control of FRNSW premises.

Most FRNSW workplaces will already have 'No-Smoking' or 'Smoke-Free Workplace' signage displayed. Such signage is sufficient and may remain in place.

If workplaces need to update signage, arrangements can be made via Zone or Business Unit Managers to order 'No Smoking, No Vaping, No E-Cigarettes' stickers (pack of 5, 125 mm x 90 mm) via ESCAT using No: 10972 as the reference.
