## **Operational Assurance Review Policy**

The <u>Operational Assurance Review Policy</u> has been published on the Operational Improvement and Assurance toolkit on the intranet.

#### **Key points**

The <u>Operational Assurance Review Policy</u> affirms FRNSW's commitment to ensuring that safety of fire fighters and the community. Operational Assurance Reviews observe the knowledge, skills and performance of frontline operational staff and the mechanisms that support them to both identify and address operational risk.

The policy is focussed on determining the current state of operational readiness and outlines the key responsibilities of staff involved before, during and after this process.

#### Who needs to read this instruction?

This policy needs to be read and understood by all Fire Fighters and Officers. Other staff should be aware of this policy, as an Operational Assurance Review may lead to suggestions for improvement in their area of responsibility.

#### **Key points**

The After Action Review Policy

- After Action Reviews provide a forum to reflect on team performance, aimed at reinforcing positive behaviours and actions (sustain) and identifying areas for improvement (improve).
- AARs are conducted after incidents and may also be held for exercises and major events, contributing to continuous improvement of operations.
- Thematic insights resulting from individual observations and AAR's are risk assessed and may invoke a working action plan, recorded on the Operational Improvement and Assurance register.

This policy needs to be read and understood by all Fire Fighters and Officers. Other staff should be aware of and understand this policy, as an After Action Review, may lead to suggestions for improvement in their area of responsibility.

## **ANZAC Day 2023**

ANZAC Day is a National Day of Remembrance that goes beyond the anniversary of the landings at Gallipoli in 1915. It is the day on which we remember all Australians who served and died in war operations and on operational service. The spirit of ANZAC, with its qualities of courage, comradeship, and self-sacrifice continues to have meaning and relevance for our sense of National identity.

#### **ANZAC Day March**

The aim of the ANZAC Day March is to give the participating veterans, ex-services personnel and the public an opportunity to honour those who served in the defence of Australia or its interests, especially remembering those who paid the supreme sacrifice or otherwise suffered because of their service. The Returned and Services League of Australia (RSL) has granted permission for FRNSW to march in the Newcastle ANZAC Day March as a Unit under Command.

#### **Eligibility to March**

Eligibility to march in the ANZAC Day March is determined by the Returned and Services League of Australia. In short, anyone eligible to be a member of the RSL is eligible to participate in the ANZAC Day March. One descendant of a deceased veteran may also honour their relative's service by wearing the relative's medals on their right breast.

#### **Dress**

Dress uniform (full ceremonial) for uniformed personnel.

Lounge suit/smart casual for administrative and trades personnel

#### Protocol for wearing medals.

Current and former FRNSW employees who have been awarded FRNSW Commendations and Awards who wish to honour a relative's war service by wearing their relative's medals should wear the relative's medals on the right breast below their FRNSW Commendations and Awards.

#### Consumption of alcohol while in uniform

FRNSW employees must not consume alcohol while in FRNSW uniform or wearing any identifiable part of FRNSW uniform, provided that the Commissioner may grant exemptions to allow the consumption of alcohol at work or whilst in uniform at special events. In these circumstances workers must ensure that alcohol is consumed in a responsible manner, consistent with upholding the reputation and integrity of FRNSW.
