PROCEDURES

Corporate office wear uniform

The <u>Recommended practice</u>, <u>Corporate office wear uniform</u> has been published on the <u>Corporate office wear uniform</u> toolkit on the Intranet.

Who needs to read this?

Senior managers, administration staff, trade staff and technical staff must read this document.

Key points

Branded corporate office wear uniform is now available to all administration staff, trade staff, and technical staff to order on ESCAT.

The corporate office wear uniform is not compulsory, although an Assistant Commissioner or Director may request that staff wear the corporate office wear uniform when representing FRNSW in some capacities.

Wearing and maintaining items

All items must be worn in accordance with the Recommended practice. Refer to the Recommended practice for further information regarding the provision, wearing, maintenance, replacement, and disposal of the uniform.

Items which should no longer be worn and disposal process

From 3 July 2023, only items listed in the Recommended practice may be worn.

All previously issued NSWFB and FRNSW corporate uniform should be disposed of in accordance with the below schedule.

Item	Branding	Disposal process
NSWFB branded clothing purchased personally by staff	NSWFB	Staff may remove and destroy branding by cutting it up and disposing in local rubbish and keep the garment for personal use.
All previous iterations of NSWFB and FRNSW corporate uniform paid for and supplied by FRNSW, including those procured by local arrangements	NSWFB FRNSW	
Winter polar fleece jacket	FRNSW	Staff may remove and destroy branding by cutting it up and disposing in local rubbish
Navy blue ribbed sweater	FRNSW	and keep the garment for personal use.
		Staff may bag and place in laundry to LHD with a blue tag marked 'For disposal'. The garment/s will have branding removed and be donated to charity.
		Alternatively, destroy the branding by cutting, and dispose of the garment in the local rubbish.

All staff are reminded of the provisions of Section 63B of the <u>State Emergency and Rescue</u> <u>Management Act 1989</u>. It is an offence to:

- Sell emergency services insignia (which includes uniforms, insignia, emblems, logos, devices, accoutrements, or any part of them).
- Use or display emergency services organisation insignia or impersonate an emergency services organisation officer with the intention to deceive.

All staff retaining items listed above must read this legislation.

Upon cessation of employment with FRNSW, staff must return all uniforms to FRNSW by placing in laundry to LHD with a blue tag marked 'For disposal'. This applies in all locations, both Metro and Regional. Further information regarding disposal can be found on the <u>Disposals</u> toolkit.
